The APIE Mentor Program is a school-based program available at any AISD middle and high school interested in participation. Mentors help students deal with day-to-day challenges, develop social-emotional skills, and improve their academic experience.

APIE mentors are volunteers from various backgrounds (i.e. college students, working professionals, retirees) and have varying levels of experience supporting adolescent youth. Mentors are screened, attend a 90-minute orientation, and receive ongoing check-ins and support throughout the school year.
